There is a meeting of the **GLA Transport Group** on **11 January** and we seek help from you to find out how the new arrangements at Archway are working so that we can submit representations to that Committee to support our call for an urgent review.

This is what we would like you to do:

Make a diary note of anything you notice; examples include:

- overcrowding after school at the 210 bus stop on St. John's Way (we have written to Parliament Hill, William Ellis, La Sainte Union and St. Aloysius Schools about this)
- school children crossing Archway Road in a risky way (we have written to St. Aloysius about this)
- buses on Archway Road idling their engines
- more traffic on local roads

Ask the TfL personnel providing information about bus stops to destinations to see if they know and appreciate how inconvenient it is, such as:

- how do I get to the Hospital? (seems obvious but it isn't!)
- how do I get to North Road or Hampstead Lane or Wellington, for example?
- how do I get to Crouch End? or Muswell Hill
- where can I catch all the buses that go north up Archway Road?
- where can I catch all buses going up Highgate Hill?
